- helping children and families explore the Christian faith in creative and dynamic ways;
- encouraging and inspiring our church family to get involved in children and families' mission.

If you're excited by this opportunity and you'd like to come and join us, you'll need to:

- have previous relevant experience of leading work with children and families in a church or charity;
- be flexible, confident and innovative in expressing the Christian faith;
- possess strong communications, team leadership and organisational skills.

As you'll be working with children and vulnerable adults, the appointment does require a satisfactory enhanced DBS Disclosure with barred list check. To succeed in sharing the Church's mission, an occupational requirement exists for the appointee to be a practising Christian.

NEXT STEPS & MAIN TERMS

Hours of work:	22.5 hours per week, with core hours of 10:15 to 12:15 on Sundays to lead Junior Church. The remaining hours can be worked flexibly over four to five days, Monday to Sunday, in agreement with your Line Manager, and will include teatime, evening and weekend work. You will not be expected to work on more than five days per calendar week.
Contract:	One Year Fixed Term Contract, with the potential to extend subject to review and funding.
Rate of pay:	Between £14.21 and £16.00 per hour (actual salary between £16,625 and £18,720 for 22.5 hours per week, with annual review), dependent on experience and qualifications, with enrolment in the Church's workplace pension scheme.
Location:	Based at Lindley Methodist Church, Huddersfield with the opportunity for some homeworking in agreement with your Line Manager.
